What is the YELLOW PINE RAIL TRAIL?

...a hiking, mountain biking, and horse trail built on the old Yellow Pine RR bed.

Why build the YELLOW PINE RAIL TRAIL?

...Take control of our own future by becoming a center of outdoor recreation, bringing a new economic base to the town.

How will the YELLOW PINE RAIL TRAIL be paid for?

...BLM money for recreation that comes from sale of land in Las Vegas Valley.

What's in it for me?

...Preserve what's good about Goodsprings:

Clean Air

Preserve historic town

Quiet

Safe

...Slow development – keep Goodsprings a small town in a big open space.

When will the YELLOW PINE RAIL TRAIL be built?

...Feasibility study will first be made, to be sure the project can be built and be successful.

...This first step will begin in Spring 2008.

...If the plan is feasible, another BLM grant will be applied for to begin building the trail.

TALKING POINTS:

Project is supported by Clark County and BLM.
BLM and County money to be spent in Goodsprings on Recreational Trail.

Non-motorized recreation promoted by this trail.
Preserve historic sites by developing appropriate use.
Scale of development fits with Goodsprings historic size.

ORV use - Curtail, eliminate use in area immediately adjacent to town.
Public races removed to more appropriate settings away from town.
Remove significant source of noise and dust in Goodsprings from ORV use.
