

## **Calling all Soup Makers of Clark County**

Do your friends tell you that you make the best soup? Do you have a historic recipe you want to share? Do you just want to come and taste some delicious soup? Then we have an event for you.

The Goodsprings Historical Society is hosting a Soup Cook Off on Saturday, January 19 at the Goodsprings Community Center from 12:00 noon to 1:15 pm followed by a bake sale auction run by Pat Pinkerton. Entrance fees for the contest will be used for winning soup prizes. All other funds raised at the event will be used for the Goodsprings School 100th Anniversary Celebration on May 4 and 5.

### **Rules for the event**

1. Each soup contestant must fill out a registration form. Due to the Goodsprings Community Center electrical restrictions, we will be forced to accept only the first 10 participants. Registration deadline is January 10th, 2013. All forms should be returned by that date along with \$5 for an entrance fee and a copy of your recipe. If you do not have an exact recipe, you may send a complete list of ingredients. If there are 10 contestants, the prizes will be: 1<sup>st</sup>, \$25; 2<sup>nd</sup>, \$15; 3<sup>rd</sup>, \$10. If there are fewer than 10, the prize money will be adjusted accordingly. If you are one of the lucky first 10 contestants, you will be notified by email or phone by Jan. 11. The success of the event depends on the cooks, so we will need a firm commitment from each participant. If anything happens that prohibits you from participating, please contact Mary Blake at 702-645-7736.
2. All soup must be made from scratch and not started from a commercial soup base.
3. The amount of soup given out during the contest will be a small cup. We will provide cups, spoons, napkins, crackers, beverages, and voting forms.
4. Guests who wish to taste soups and vote for the People's Choice will purchase 10 tickets and a ballot for \$5.00. Each ticket will "pay" a soup cooker for one sample. Remember, this is a fundraiser for the Goodsprings School Anniversary, so please do not give out samples without receiving a ticket. You are expected to remain with your soup the entire time or have a representative there for you.
5. We will provide a sign for your soup that has a number prominently displayed and the recipe/ingredients for your soup. Voters will use that number to select their favorites. The recipe/ingredients on the sign will be taken from your registration form.
6. The public event will begin promptly at 12:00 noon and finish at 1:15 pm. Set up will be between 11:00 and 11:45 am. Winners will be announced as soon as the ballots are counted. A bake sale auction will follow the presentation of prizes.
